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CRAFTING DIALOGUES?

The current international geopolitical context of conflicts, political, economic, social, environmental uncertainties and the new fragilities, especially in terms of affordable housing and working conditions, in Milan, present us with necessary choices and changes. Building new devices to dialogue, find synergies and carry out collaborative projects, but also to fight and protest in the most diverse forms (demonstrations, solidarity bicycle rides, sit-ins and occupation camps...). Crafting Dialogues gives space to new design tools and critical and collective action.

At Stecca3 we are pleased again this year to welcome and give space and visibility to these critical issues and craft new project and conversation opportunities with designers, artisans, architects, journalists, curators and experts, local, Italian and international Institutions.

What will we discuss about? Experimenting pop-up shops, where you can test **alternative forms of exchange**, but also rediscover neighborhood shops and a proximity economy.

Are we truly facing a new model based on the revitalization of the local economic fabric through **neighborhood relations and social and environmental relationships**, which also revolve around small businesses and local products?

On which vision and economic models is the city based? Can international competition and attractiveness be based on major events such as the Salone del Mobile, Biennials, Triennials or future Olympic Games? What is the legacy and impact on local communities?

Will we talk about it with experts, institutions and activists. Shall we try to dialogue and build collaborative projects?

In Milan the **proximity economy** is also a collaborative economy when it also includes **hybrid socio-cultural spaces**, managed by associations and cultural entrepreneurs that provide self-organised services to the neighbourhoods, subsidiary but not substitutes for municipal services.
